Objectives and results of the action		Objective: To raise cognitive and socio-emotional competencies of youth and adult groups on climate crisis, human rights for a healthy environment, safe climate and sustainable development, bio-diversity losses, clean energy solutions, sustainable cities and communities as well as responsible production and consumption through trainings, social media communication campaigns and advocacy initiatives. Indicators: Number of prepared training modules by the CSO. Number of campaigns conducted by the CSO. Number of information materials such as booklets/brochures/leaflets prepared and disseminated by the CSO. Number of people reached through awareness campaigns, publications, activities realized.			

Results achieved:

- 1. September 15, 2019 *Çubuk Krakerin Yolculuğu* Festivali (*Journey of Stick Cracker* Festival): This was a festival for deaf children including several workshops from art workshops to science and technology workshops. It was coordinated by Anlatan Eller (Narrating Hands) Association. Kozalak Association contributed to the organization of the event and implemented an environmental workshop, called Journey to the World of Seed, for target children. It enabled both deaf and non-deaf children to meet with soil and seed in an urban setting by preparing seed balls and throwing them into soil to flourish. It was held in 5 sessions with a total of 100 children.
- 2. March 1-2, 2020 Volunteering and Volunteer Management Training for Bilecik Municipality staff: It was carried out with the request of Bilecik municipality in order to increase the knowledge and awareness of municipality staff on volunteering and volunteer management. Corporate volunteer policy texts were prepared with 15 municipal employees. The training was designed by the program team of Kozalak Association by taking the needs of the Municipality into account.

A live broadcast was held via Instagram on the 3rd of April during Global Digital Climate Strike. Fridays With Fridays for Future activists we talked about climate action and the role of young women in fighting the climate crisis. With our third guest as a young female academic studying ecosystem, we talked about the relations between climate crisis and biodiversity. About 150 people watched the broadcast and conveyed their comments and questions during the event.

4. April 15-22, 2020 - Earth Day Events:

Open Radio Climate Emergency Program:

Emine Özkan (Board member and Networking Coordinator) and Nagihan Demirsu (Board Member and Awareness-raising Coordinators) from Kozalak Association has participated Climate Emergency Program prepared by climate activist Can Tombil for Open Radio on 17th of April. They informed audiences on Kozalak Association, including its vision and mission as well as activities conducting, and the importance of the Earth Day. In addition, they announced which activities Kozalak Association for Earth Day including social media campaign and *Words of the Earth* workshop.

Social Media Campaign for Combating the Climate Crisis at Home: The theme of the Earth Day 2020 was Climate Action. In accordance to the theme selected, Kozalak Association conducted a social media campaign from 15th to 22nd of April which aims at raising awareness on what we can do to combat the climate crisis at our homes within the constraints of COVID-19 conditions. 24 different social media posts including 24 different suggestions were shared with our followers in our social media accounts, Facebook, Instagram and Twitter, during the campaign which was also supported through paid advertisements.

Words of the Earth Workshop: On April 22, an online workshop designed by the education team of Kozalak Association, was held with 17 participants. This workshop began with the history of Earth Day then tried to demonstrate why global citizenship identities should be fostered all over the countries against climate change and biodiversity losses despite and against existing international and social divisions. It was based on experiential learning and non-formal education methodologies such as collective story-writing, emotion-sharing and interactive group works. The workshop was ended with a letter written collectively and spontaneously by the participants from the mouth of the Earth 2050. A video of the letter with animations was also later prepared and released in social media accounts. As of 15th of May 2020 the video has been shown 347 times and received 55 interactions.

5. Global Histories for Global Citizens – History webinars:

May 3, 2020 - History Webinar 1 Revisiting History in Corona and Climate Crisis Days: Black Death This webinar is about the history of the Black Death which was a plague pandemic covering Europe and Ottoman worlds in the 14th and 15th centuries. The webinar narrated for 15 participants how ecosystem components, including a pathogen, host animals, vector organisms, humans and environment and climate, were interacted in multiple ways and led to dramatic social, economic, cultural and political consequences including the demise of feudalism, peasant insurgencies, delaying marriages and Renaissance.
